

Traffic Concerns

- ▶ In an effort to promote traffic flow in the morning, we are taking the suggestions of district and city officials and piloting the following:
 - ▶ We will close the loop in front of the school. There will be no drop-offs in this area from October 9th – 13th. If you have students with special concerns, please contact Mr. Issa at 619-591-4000.
 - ▶ We are encouraging parents to drop off and continue in the same direction.
 - ▶ If you are heading south on Duncan Road, we are designating the areas directly in front of the school as drop-off zones. There will be signs to assist.
 - ▶ If you are heading north on Duncan Road, there is a drop-off in the parking lot that is across from the the school. You can enter and exit in a circular fashion and continue north on Duncan Road.

Traffic Concerns Continued

- ▶ Traffic is heaviest at the corner of Duncan Ranch Road and Stone Gate Drive from 7:50 to 8:10 AM. We will do our best to have an adult assisting with students during these times.
- ▶ We have contacted Traffic Engineering to increase the time for the left turn from Stone Gate Drive to Hunte Parkway in the morning and afternoon.
- ▶ Another drop-off point to consider includes the west side on Stone Gate Drive near the side of the school about 20 yards up heading toward Hunte Parkway. Do not park near the corner as it impedes traffic for those turning right.
- ▶ The library is open from 7:15 to 8:10 with an adult supervisor. I highly recommend having your student dropped off at an earlier time as well.
- ▶ Please have your student ready with their materials (backpack, lunch, etc.) as you drop off. It will help with traffic flow.
