Shots Required

California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at TK/Kindergarten through 12th grade and **all students advancing to seventh grade before entry**. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof.

Per California law SB 277, schools are no longer allowed to accept a personal or religious beliefs exemption to currently required vaccines.

- Students **will not be able to register** unless an up-to-date immunization record is provided at the time of registration.
- All incoming 7th and 8th grade students **MUST** have the following immunizations:

Vaccine	Doses Required
Polio (OPV or IPV)	4 doses (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday.)
Hepatitis B (Hep B or HBV)	3 doses
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, Tdap, DTP, Td, or DT)	5 doses (4 doses OK if last dose was given on or after 4th birthday.) OR (3 doses OK if one was given on or after seventh birthday.)
TDAP - DTP Booster (Adacel or Boostrix)	1 dose (Given on or after seventh birthday.)
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR or MMR-V)	2 doses (Both doses given on or after 1 st birthday.)
Varicella (chicken pox) (VAR, MMR-V, or VZV)	2 doses

Vacunas requeridas

Se requiere que las escuelas en California verifiquen los comprobantes de inmunización de todos los nuevos estudiantes ingresando a Pre-Kinder/Kinder hasta doceavo grado y de **todos los estudiantes que están por ingresar al séptimo grado**. Los padres deben presentar el comprobante de vacunas de su hijo (a) como prueba de inmunización.

- **No se admitirá** a los estudiantes al menos que se presente el comprobante de vacunación y que las vacunas estén al día.
- Todos los alumnos que ingresen al séptimo grado ó al octavo grado necesitaran las siguientes vacunas:

Vacuna	Dosis Requeridas
Polio (OPV o IPV)	4 dosis (3 dosis cumplen con el requisito si una se aplicó al cumplir los 4 años de edad o después.)
Anti-hepatitis B (Hep B o HBV)	3 dosis
La difteria, el tétanos y la tosferina (DTap, Tdap, DTP, Td, o DT)	5 dosis (4 dosis cumplen con el requisito si la última se aplicó al cumplir los 4 años de edad o después.) o (3 dosis cumplen con el requisito si se administró a los 7 años o después.)
TDAP- DTP Booster (Adacel o Boostrix)	1 dosis (Cumplen con el requisito si se aplicó al cumplir 7 años de edad o después.)
El sarampión (MMR o MMR-V)	2 dosis (Se requieren 2 dosis al cumplir un año de edad o después.)
Varicela (VAR, MMR-V, o VZV)	2 dosis
